A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING CONTINUED STATE FUNDING FOR PUBLIC BROADCASTING AND KYUK TV/RADIO

WHEREAS, KYUK Radio provides vital information for the health and well-being of the residents of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, KYUK Radio broadcasts most local programs in the Yup'ik language to insure understanding and comprehension of important local issues; and

WHEREAS, KYUK Radio provides current weather, fishing period information, and emergency messages and broadcasts; and

WHEREAS, KYUK Radio is instrumental in the preservation of the Yup'ik language and culture; and

WHEREAS, KYUK Radio provides live broadcasts of the Bethel City Council, allowing citizens greater access to our local government; and

WHEREAS, KYUK TV provides distance delivery of educational material on the satellite to all local school sites through the DDC for teacher in-service, National Guard training, University of Alaska classes, and health aide training with the Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation; and

WHEREAS, KYUK TV provides superior, high-quality, educational children's and adult television programming, as well as Alaskan programming from the Alaska Public Broadcasting Service; and

WHEREAS, KYUK Radio and Television is a key volunteer attraction which includes our citizens in safe, sober activities; and


