**TEMPORARY ORDINANCE #94-01**

**A TEMPORARY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.04.030 ENTITLED ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR NINETY DAYS BY MOVING PEOPLE TO BE HEARD IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ROLL CALL ON THE CITY COUNCIL AGENDA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Bethel City Council is developing Council Policies and Procedures which will include meeting protocol, parliamentary guidelines and Council job responsibilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the policies and procedures provide for a change to the Council agenda which would move People to be Heard to the beginning of the agenda; and

**WHEREAS**, it is required that an ordinance be passed and approved to change the order in which the City Council conducts business; and

**WHEREAS**, before introducing an ordinance for passage, Council members wish to conduct a trial period to determine if the change to the agenda will be of benefit to both Council and the public.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ordained as follows:

Section 1: This is a non-Code ordinance.

Section 2: The City Council of the City of Bethel hereby changes the order of business by moving People to be Heard immediately following Roll Call on the City Council agenda.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption for ninety days.
