

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL REQUESTING GRANT IN AID CONSTRUCTION FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BETHEL PUMP STATION AND SEWAGE LINE AND AUTHORIZING CITY ADMINISTRATION TO CARRY OUT ALL NECESSARY FUNCTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the present pumps in the Lift Station in Bethel Height is inadequate to meet the project need in the immediate future, and;

WHEREAS, the present water and sewer lines in ASHA are steel, but the line from the pump station to the lagoon is P.V.C., and require much maintenance, and;

WHEREAS, the City has Village Safe Water funds as match for this grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration is directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain an Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation Construction in Aid Grant for the design and construction of a sewer line from the Bethel Pump Station to the Sewage Lagoon and to increase the Bethel Pump Station., and Sewage Lagoon improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of te City Council, as Council's authorized representative in accepting and implementing the grant award if funded.
