A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS #02-14 & #07-16, BOTH IN SUPPORT OF TRANSFERRING THE PORT OF BETHEL MUNICIPAL DOCK FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO THE CITY OF BETHEL.


WHEREAS, the Port of Bethel serves a broad area including communities both up and down the Kuskokwim River;

WHEREAS, many individuals who live in communities both up and down the river rely on the operation of the port to meet their needs of obtaining life-supporting goods and services;

WHEREAS, as many as twenty-nine communities have been identified by Northern Economics, Inc. as being served by the Port of Bethel representing a population for greater than the City of Bethel alone.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Bethel hereby rescind Ordinance #02-14 & #07-16 previously passed by Council, supporting the transfer the City dock area and surrounding uplands from the State of Alaska to the City of Bethel, proposed by the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
