

RESOLUTION #631

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel seeks to develop infrastructure facilities necessary to accommodate the water, sewer, and solid waste needs, and establish a safe system of roads within the Bethel Community; and

WHEREAS, many very basic water, sewer, and solid waste needs in Bethel are being minimally met and the roads are currently in such poor condition that they clearly present a hazard to public safety; and


WHEREAS, the City must insure for the public safety and health of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City's Sewage Lagoon and Solid Waste Landfill Dump are currently at capacity and funding is critical in order to solve these problems; and

WHEREAS, the City has inadequate financial resources for repairs to the Community's roads.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Bethel establishes water, sewer, solid waste, and roads as it's priorities for Capital Funding in Fiscal Year 1990.
