A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, TO GIVE ITS SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT TO THE EFFORT TO BRING THE "NADEZHDA--HOPE SLED DOG RACE" TO THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel hopes to continue establishing further ties with its sister city, Anadyr, Chukotka, Russia; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel hopes to further establish its reputation as a home of world class sled dog racing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel recognizes the economic benefits which can be derived from hosting an international event of this size; and

WHEREAS, the Kuskokwim 300 Sled Dog Race Committee has received a letter from the Chief Administrator of the City of Anadyr, L.P. Kanivets, requesting the committee's help in organizing a race between Bethel and Anadyr under the Nadezhda--Hope Race banner; and


WHEREAS, the Kuskokwim 300 Sled Dog Race Committee has agreed to give organizational support to explore the feasibility of conducting such an event; and


