SUPPORT FOR THE PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATION TO ALASKA'S RURAL TRANSIT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO REQUEST TRAINING AND TRAVEL FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel relies on grant funding to support the training needs of Bethel Public Transit System personnel;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, Transit Division, is currently accepting applications for Alaska's Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP), a Federal Transit Administration program providing funds to train transit system personnel;

WHEREAS, there is an on-going need to train the City's transit manager and transit bus drivers in order to meet federal, state, and local requirements and to elevate the level of service capability;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel will request training and travel expenses that will likely be in the range of \$3,000 to \$5,000;

WHEREAS, there is no match required for RTAP funds;

WHEREAS, applications are due March 26, 2010;


