

RESOLUTION # 489

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THAT BOATOWNERS REMOVE THEIR BOATS FROM THE END OF THE MISSION ROAD SEAWALL AND THAT ALL INDIVIDUALS STAY OFF THE SANDBAGS.

WHEREAS, erosion control is a major problem for the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the area at the end of the Mission Road Seawall has undergone extensive erosion; and

WHEREAS, the City has spent over \$70,000 attempting to stop erosion using sandbags and other means; and

WHEREAS, boats are being anchored and pulled up on the sandbags tearing them apart and endangering the erosion control efforts.

WHEREAS, individuals are walking on the sandbags and using the area for other purposes endangering themselves and the erosion control efforts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that boats are hereby prohibited from tying up at the end of the Seawall in the area where the sandbags are placed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police Department is authorized to take whatever action is necessary to remove and impound boats that are tied up in the sandbag area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that individuals are asked not to walk on the sandbags or to utilize the area for any purpose.
