

RESOLUTION # 324

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT THE NEW STATE JAIL FACILITY TO BE LOCATED IN BETHEL, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated approximately \$6,000,000.00, for planning, design and construction of the Bethel State Jail; and,

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 35.15.080, provides a mechanism by which municipal governments can contract with the State of Alaska to carry out construction projects located within the municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has demonstrated experience and expertise in the planning, design and construction of public use facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel would be able to begin construction during the FY81 construction season allowing for maximum use of construction dollars; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is in a position to convey public lands to the State of Alaska in a timely enough manner so as not to delay construction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL THAT the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain funds from the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for the planning, design, and construction of the proposed Bethel State Jail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant funds.
