ORDINANCE #01-38

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD PROVISION FOR SALE OF METERED WATER IN BULK QUANTITIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Chapter 13.04. Chapter 13.04 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended to add the following section:


13.04.085 Sale of Metered Water in Bulk

Sale of metered water in quantities of 100 gallons or more per fill shall be permitted only pursuant to a written contract executed between the City of Bethel and the party proposing to buy water in bulk. The City Manager is authorized to enter into such contracts on behalf of the City of Bethel.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
