CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Cooke at 7.35 P.M.

PETITION FOR LOCAL OPTION ELECTION REGARDING SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS:

A member of the audience asked how long after an election you had to wait to call another election on the same topic. No answer was available, but Shuler will check with the City Attorney.

Harland Davis and John Shuler have checked the petition signatures against registration rolls a year old and Harland Davis, City Attorney, certified 197 signatures on the petition from the registration rolls used, 153 signatures were needed to place the issue on the ballot at a Special Election. Thus the City Attorney certifies that enough qualified signatures are on the petition to call a special election.

M/M Hoffman, Crow: I move we accept the petition and that a Special Election on the issue of intoxicating liquors on a separate ballot be held October 2, 1973. Roll Call Vote: all present voted yes. Motion Passed.
