

RESOLUTION 468

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE TO REPEAL THE CHILD SAFETY RESTRAINT LAW AS IT APPLIES TO SHARED RIDE CAB SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the 1985 Alaska State Legislature passed the Child Safety Restraint Law; and

WHEREAS, the Child Safety Restraint Law is applicable to taxi-cab operations, including shared ride taxi-cab systems; and


WHEREAS, the Child Safety Restraint Law as applied to shared ride taxi-cab systems is costly and burdensome to both passenger and taxi operator by requiring all children, whether accompanied by an adult or not, to be restrained by a child safety device.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that the Bethel City Council hereby requests that the Alaska State Legislature exempt from the Child Safety Restraint Law shared ride taxi-cab operations.
