RESOLUTION #93-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, IDENTIFYING ITS PRIORITIES UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel City Council has identified road projects as a Capital Improvements Projects Priority; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation is soliciting comments and involvement from affected communities on their Draft Priority List; and

WHEREAS, Bethel serves as a regional transportation hub for the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure of the road system in Bethel is deteriorating rapidly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council identifies the following priorities for the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program as the following: #1 Roads Priorities--Ptarmigan Road Upgrade, Ridgecrest Drive Reconstruction, Brown Slough Bridge Replacement, Akakeek Street Improvement, Tundra Ridge Road Improvement; #1 Airport Priorities--Runway Stabilization and Taxiway Construction; #1 General Fund Priorities--Bank Stabilization Project; #2 Roads Priorities--7th Avenue Improvement, Main Street Improvement; #4 Roads Priorities--East Avenue Improvement, Sanitation Road to Sewage Lagoon; and #4 Airport Priorities--Airport Apron Expansion, Airport Taxiway Expansion.


