A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CHANGE IN TERMINAL TARIFF #003, ITEM: WARFAGE-FEE & CHARGES (B) BULK PETROLEUM PRODUCTS INBOUND

WHEREAS, the Bethel Small Boat Harbor is the gateway to subsistence, recreational, and commercial activities for the people of the community;

WHEREAS, the infrastructure within the Small Boat Harbor has deteriorated to the point of being a potential liability;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has been awarded a matching grant from the Denali Commission up to \$520,000 to replace deteriorated infrastructure;

WHEREAS, these necessary improvements should be funded with minimum financial impact to the community;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel Port Commission has reviewed and held public hearings with the purpose of obtaining comments from the general public on a proposed increase to the through-put surcharge;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Bethel hereby increases the through-put fuel surcharge from \$.04 to \$.06 for each gallon going through the City of Bethel petroleum port.
