RESOLUTION NO. 295

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL TO FUNDS TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER.

WHEREAS, The State Legislature, through HB 60, has approved a Municipal grant in the amount of \$400,000 for the purpose of covering the construction cost overruns on the Senior Citizens Center; and

WHEREAS, funds to plan, design and construct a 9,000 sq. ft. Senior Citizens Center have been allocated by the State of Alaska and the project is under construction; and

WHEREAS, due to increased labor and material costs, the City is requesting funds to cover cost overruns on the construction phase of the Senior Citizens Center project; and


WHEREAS, the grant will allow the City to complete the facility in a timely manner and provide a recreational center for the seniors of Bethel.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL THAT THE CITY ADMINISTRATION BE DIRECTED TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO OBTAIN MUNICIPAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING THE SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER.


