RESOLUTION #01-13

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE BETHEL FIRE DEPARTMENT IN SEEKING GRANT MONEY

WHEREAS, Bethel Fire Department has identified grant monies from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and is willing to put forth the effort needed to apply for the grant, and;

WHEREAS, Congress gave FEMA the authority to carry out an initiative to provide assistance to firefighters and this assistance will be awarded directly to local fire departments on a competitive basis, and;

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department identified two grant categories to apply for funding— training and safety equipment, and;

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department would use the training money to move the existing training tower facility to a hazard-free location near the main fire station and renovate the facility as necessary, and;

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department would use the safety equipment money to purchase personal protective equipment for firefighters, EMT volunteers and search and rescue volunteers, and;

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department is in need of additional monies to fund projects for the safety and protection of the Bethel community.


