ORDINANCE #00-11

A ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OPERATIONS OF PAWNBROKERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is general and permanent in nature and shall be a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Content. Section 5.20.010.D. of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Section 5.20.010.D. *Bond.* An applicant for a pawnbroker's license shall file a surety bond in the amount of \$25,000 with her/her initial application. The applicant shall deliver the original bond to the city. The bond shall provide that the bonding company shall contact the city thirty (30) days prior to cancellation of the surety bond. The bond shall also require the bonding company to issue a yearly certificate of continuing coverage to the city, regardless of whether the bond provides for continuing coverage until notification of termination,

SECTION 3. Content. Section 5.20.020.A. of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:


Section 5.20.020.A. *Hours.* A pawnbroking establishment may be open for the transaction of business only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and [8:00] 10:00 p.m.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
