### **Resolution # 09-09**

#### **APPROVAL OF BETHEL COMMUNITY SERVICE PATROL GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS TO OPERATE A THREE-PERSON COMMUNITY SERVICE PATROL UNIT**

**WHEREAS**, the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services offered the City of Bethel a non-competitive grant to fund a community service patrol unit;

**WHEREAS**, the grant period extends until June 30, 2009 with no match requirement and no obligation to continue the program afterward with City funds;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel prepared and submitted a project description, budget, and budget narrative outlining how the proposed Bethel Community Service Patrol program would operate in Bethel;

**WHEREAS**, the Bethel Community Service Patrol program would provide safe transportation of individuals under the influence of drugs and alcohol that are a danger to themselves or others to a sleep-off center for recovery;

**WHEREAS**, the City building that formerly housed the Korean Church was described in the grant as the future office of the CSP unit;


**WHEREAS**, the City's proposed grant budget contains a \$5,000 line item to cover renovation of the future CSP office building and \$8,400 to the City as facility rent;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council approves the City of Bethel's participation in the Community Service Patrol Grant Program and agrees to comply with the grant requirements spelled out in the grant agreement.
