A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT AN AWARD OF \$71,283 FROM THE FY 2003 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM II

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management, has \$1,191,002 available for distribution to protect critical infrastructure as part of the FY 2003 State Homeland Security Grant Program II;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is one of 30 jurisdictions in the state eligible to receive grant funds from this program;

WHEREAS, a State Homeland Security Grant application was prepared and submitted by the City of Bethel on April 25, 2005;


WHEREAS, the grant award provides funding to purchase a video surveillance system to monitor the main water treatment facility and an electric gate and flood lights for the City's Petro Port;

WHEREAS, the funds received from this Homeland Security Grant must be expended by October 31, 2005;

WHEREAS, no cash match is required for this grant;


