RESOLUTION #322

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO CONSTRUCT A SHELTER CABIN ON THE KISARALIK RIVER, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AS COUNCIL'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ACCEPTANCE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS GRANT AWARD.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature in 1979, through FCCSSB 53, has approved a municipal grant to the City of Bethel in the amount of \$10,000, to construct a shelter cabin on the Kiseralik River; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a pressing need for emergency shelters that may provide safe haven for individuals traveling between villages; and,


WHEREAS, no shelter cabins currently exist.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, direct the City Administration to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Transportation for the City of Bethel to construct a shelter cabin on the Kiseralik River.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or his designee is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in the acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
