

ORDINANCE NO. 136


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL ESTABLISHING A CITY OF
BETHEL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982-83 AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money as may be needed
or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and
liabilities of the City of Bethel are hereby
appropriated for the corporate purpose and objects
of the City of Bethel for the fiscal year commencing
on the FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1982 and ending on the
THIRTIETH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1983.

SECTION 2. That the budget is adopted for a period of one (1)
year in accordance with AS 29.48.190.

AMENDMENT NO. 1
to
ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF BETHEL BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR
FY '83, COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1982 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER
30, 1983.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, THAT
THE FY '83 BETHEL CITY BUDGET IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money as may be needed
or deemed necessary to defray expenses and liabilities of the
City of Bethel are hereby appropriated for the corporate
purpose and objects of the City of Bethel hereinafter specified
for the fiscal year from the first day of October, 1982 and
ending the thirtieth day of September, 1983.

SECTION 2. Fund budgets to be revised and the revised total
expenditures are as follows:

a. General Government	\$6,826,504
b. Federal Revenue Sharing	480,222
c. Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center	890,777
d. Municipal Dock Enterprise	132,675
e. Bowling Alley Enterprise	96,009


Schedules 1 through 5 attached give additional information
