## RESOLUTION #98-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL, INCREASING ANIMAL IMPOUNDMENT FEES BY 25 PERCENT

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has an Animal Control Ordinance in effect, which provides for the impoundment of any animal not under the control of its' owner; and

WHEREAS, the cost of trapping, impounding, and providing care for animals not controlled by their owners is incurred by the City of Bethel Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the current fee for animal impoundment is \$15.00 per day; and


WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council finds it desirable to increase this fee, to serve as a greater incentive for residents to control their animals, and to adequately reimburse the City for their costs

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, hereby increases the animal impoundment fee by 25%, from \$15.00 per day to \$18.75 per day, and directs the Bethel City Administration to begin charging and collecting the increased fee effective March 1, 1998, after giving public notice of the increase.
