## CITY COUNCIL MINUTES SEPTEMBER 24, 1980

### COUNCIL CHAMBERS

Meeting called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Mayor Guinn and roll call was taken. Present: Charles, Twitchell, Carpenter and Guinn. Absent; Elliott, B. Hoffman and E. Hoffman. Quorum.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

No minutes were presented because the City Clerk was typing up the budget.

### APPROVAL OF AGENDA

M/M by Carpenter/2nd Twitchell to approve the agenda as presented. Voice vote was taken. Motion carried.

### PEOPLE TO BE HEARD

Harold Napoleon gave a report on the purposes of conducting a Regional Government Study within the region. He stated the Senate and House Committee on Regional Affairs had proposed a number of bills relating to unorganized boroughs, especially the schools being built in the bushes and the Continental Shelf. The Steering Committee was formed which would neither support or oppose any proposed bills without having first studied the issues. The Steering Committee would have meeting on Oct. 19, 1980.

NEW BUSINESS


ITEM A. INTRODUCTION OF MODIFICATION OF ORDINANCE #85, REGARDING
