### **RESOLUTION #01-39**

#### **A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE BETHEL SENIOR CENTER IN ITS EFFORTS TO SECURE A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) AND CERTIFYING COMPLIANCE WITH CDBG STATE AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, The Bethel Senior Center is in need of a bus barn to keep senior center vehicles in during the winter; provide adequate dry, warm space for vehicle maintenance during summer and winter; and provide for the safety of seniors by providing shelter from the harsh weather when getting in and out of the vehicles, and;

**WHEREAS**, The Bethel Senior Center seeks a CDBG for the purpose of designing and constructing a bus barn for the center which will reduce or eliminate conditions that are detrimental to the health and safety of the seniors for whom services are provided, and;

**WHEREAS**, The Bethel City Council agrees to be in full compliance with specific applicable state and federal requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, authorizes the Bethel Senior Center to submit an application for the CDBG for the purposes stated above and certifies full compliance with all applicable state and federal regulations should the Senior Center be awarded the CDBG, and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska designates the City Manager of Bethel as the authorized representative for the City of Bethel and authorizes the City Manager to sign the CDBG application on behalf of the Bethel Senior Center.
