ORDINANCE #08-14

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 7.10.150 TO THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE - ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR FILLING VACANT COUNCILMEMBERS SEATS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Council Seat Vacancies and Multiple Terms. If there are two or more council seat vacancies with multiple term lengths, the candidate(s) receiving the greater number of votes shall fill the longest term(s). A tie vote among candidates shall be resolved by a drawing of straws; the candidate who draws the longest straw shall be deemed to be the candidate receiving the greater number of votes.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Bethel City Council to be implemented for the October 7, 2008 Regular election and thereafter.

PASSED AND APPROVED THIS 30 DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2008, BY A VOTE OF 3 IN FAVOR AND 3 OPPOSED.
