Dave Swanson introduced Jack Stearns, attorney from Anchorage, representing the Kuskokwim Inn, Inc., a group of business people interested in building a hotel in Bethel. They need or want an endorsement from the City of Bethel to Greater Anchorage Development Co.

After considerable discussions pro and con concerning the erection and need of a first class hotel in Bethel, it was the consensus of opinion that such a need existed.

Mr. Jack Stearns presented and read a copy of a prepared resolution. This resolution is for a specific project, the Kuskokwim Inn, Inc. If they desire to build any projects in the future, they will want individual approval of each project.

The Council directed that a letter be drafted to the Commissioner of Education and the Commissioner of Highways concerning access for emergency vehicles behind the public school.
