**A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE
ALASKA MUNICIPAL LEAGUE LETTER SENT TO GOVERNOR MURKOWSKI
CONCERNING THE FY05 FISCAL PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Municipal League efforts in advocating for a viable fiscal plan for Alaska are supported in Bethel;

WHEREAS, the House adopted the POMV Endowment plan with a Community Dividend to create a new relationship with local government and to strengthen and expand the role and responsibility of the local governments;

WHEREAS, a community dividend and education endowment puts money back into the hands of communities;

WHEREAS, a revenue sharing "lifeline" for small communities could be a vital financial support for communities in Alaska;

WHEREAS, a PERS "lifeline" will help alleviate local budget crisis this fiscal year;
