

ORDINANCE #115

AN ORDINANCE WHEREBY THE CITY OF BETHEL ELECTS TO COME UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF APPLICABLE STATE LAW AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL THAT:

SECTION 1. ELECTION DECLARED

The City Council hereby elected to come under AS 28.10.431 which provides for the levy of a Motor Vehcile Registration Tax for the City of Bethel.

SECTION 2. FILING NOTICE WITH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

The City Council directed the City Manager to act upon the authority of the City Council and on its behalf, filed a written notice of election with the Alaska Department of Public Safety, during a Council Meeting during the calendar year of 1979

By filing this written notice of election, the City Council understands that said notice shall not be rescinded for a subsequent fiscal year as provided in AS 28.10.431 (a). By filing this written notice of election, the City Council understands that the notice must be filed on or before January 1 of the year preceeding the year election under this section is to become effective as provided in AS 28.10.431(a). By filing this written notice of election, the City Council understands that if the City has, before the effective date of this Act, levied a motor vehicle registration or ad-valorem tax which has repealed by a vote of the people at any regular or special City election, then the election provided for in AS 28.10.431. (a) as evidence by passage of this Ordinance is not effective until the Ordinance passed by this City Council has been approved by the people at the next regularly scheduled general or special City election as provided in AS 28.10.431(a).

SECTION 3. LEGAL OBLIGATIONS

The City Council will fulfil any statutory obligations under AS 28.10.431, other applicable statues, regulations promulgated thereof.

SECTION 4. FUNDS FOR ROAD REPAIR

All funds collected from this tax shall be earmarked for road repair.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE


This Ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption by the City Council and the signature of the Mayor.

The Motor Vehicle Registration Tax will become effective January 1, 1981

ORDINANCE #115

SECTION 2. FILING NOTICE WITH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

The City Council directed the City Manager to act upon the authority of the City Council and on its behalf, filed a written notice of election with the Alaska Department of Public Safety, during a Council Meeting during the calendar year of 1978.

By filing this written notice of election, the City Council understands that said notice shall not be rescinded for a subsequent fiscal year as provided in AS 28.10.431 (a). By filing this written notice of election, the City Council understands that the notice must be filed on or before January 1 of the year preceding the year election under this section is to become effective as provided in AS 28.10.431(a). By filing this written notice of election, the City Council understands that if the City has, before the effective date of this Act, levied a motor vehicle registration or ad-valorem tax which has repealed by a vote of the people at any regular or special City election, then the election provided for in AS 28.10.431(a) as evidence by passage of this Ordinance is not effective until the Ordinance passed by this City Council has been approved by the people at the next regularly scheduled general or special city election as provided in AS 28.10.431(a).

SECTION 3. LEGAL OBLIGATIONS

The City Council will fulfil any statutory obligations under AS 28.10.431, other applicable statutes, regulations promulgated thereof.

SECTION 4. FUNDS FOR ROAD REPAIR

All funds collected from this tax shall be earmarked for road repair.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE

This Ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption by the City Council and the signature of the Mayor.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE OF TAX


The Motor Vehicle Registration Tax will become effective, January 1, 1980 if approved by the people at the next regularly scheduled general or special municipal election.
