RESOLUTION #97-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A FACILITY CAPITAL GRANT FROM THE ALASKA MENTAL HEALTH TRUST AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, the Adult Day Care (ADC) Program of the City's Senior Services Department serves a low-income, mobility-impaired frail/stroke and ADRD clientele; and

WHEREAS, the ADC Program needs to add space to the quarters housing the Program to comply with the State requirements of 60 square foot of space per client and two restrooms. The ADC Program currently has 17 clients and only 600 square feet of total available space for the Program; and only one restroom.

WHEREAS, the Senior Services Department would like to remodel the existing woodshop building adjacent to the Senior Center to house the ADC Program. The ADC Program would still benefit from the Senior Center and its meals and programs; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority's Facility Capital Grant (MHTA Facility Remodeling/Renovation Grant) is intended to upgrade the quality of services of facilities providing care to MHTA beneficiary groups. The ADC Program currently serves clients from all four of the MHTA beneficiary groups; and


WHEREAS, the Adult Day Care Program would like to apply for a grant of approximately \$300,000 from the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority to remodel the woodshop and comply with the Mental Health Trust Authority's requirement of 60 square foot of space per client and two restrooms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL that it hereby authorizes submission of the application for the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority's Facility Capital Grant, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the grant documents.
