A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF AN FFY 2010 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is one of 31 communities in Alaska eligible to participate in the State Homeland Security Grant Program administered by the State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management;

WHEREAS, funding from the FFY 2010 Homeland Security grant is meant to significantly enhance the ability of the City through the Bethel Police, Fire, Port, Information Technology, and Public Works departments to prevent, deter, and respond to emergencies stemming from acts of terrorism or natural disasters by providing money for planning, training, equipment, exercises, and supplies;

WHEREAS, the Bethel Police, Fire, Port, Information Technology, and Public Works departments have been notified of the grant opportunity and have been requested to provide the City's Grant Development Manager with project ideas, cost information, justifications, and expected project outcomes;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel was awarded an FY 2009 State Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$45,000 that is funding the cost of revising the City's Emergency Operations Plan, performing a Security Vulnerability Assessment, and delivering training courses to the City;

WHEREAS, FY 2010 State Homeland Security grant applications are due July 2, 2010 via email;

WHEREAS, there is no cash or in-kind match required from the City to participate in this grant program;


