The meeting was called to order by Mayor Arthur Nicholson. Roll was called.

New Business:

Canvass of City Election Ballots

The canvass of the election ballots were reviewed and approved by the council. M/M Crow, Laroux that the election results as attested to by the election board be accepted. Poll Vote: Crow, yes, Dull yes, Haroldsen yes, Hoffman yes, Laroux yes, Nichoson yes, Swanson yes. Motion Passed

Swearing in of Councilmen:

The newly elected councilmen swore the oath of office and signed the oath.

Election of Mayor:

Nominations were opened for Mayor. Gene Peltola and David Swanson were nominated. M/M Crow, Jack that nominations be closed. Motion passed.

Councilmen voted by secret ballot and David Swanson was elected Mayor by a vote of Swanson 4, Peltola 3.

INTERIM FINANCING:

The interim financing was explaingd to Council by Ben Marsh.

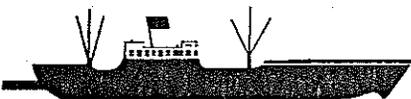
M/M Nicholson, Crow that we increase our Intærim Financing at this time to \$205,000.00

RESOLUTION 47;

M/M Nicholson, Peltola that Resolution 47 be put into its first reading. Passed Resolution 47 was put into its first reading by Mayor Swanson.

USE OF TACAN SITE PIT:

M/M Crow, Peltola that City permit 10,000 yards of fill to be placed in the Tacan site area. Poll Vote: Crow yes, Hoffman, no, Haraux no, Jack yes, Nicholson no, Peltola yes, Swanson no. 4-3 Against - Motion not carried.

Mr. Snodgrass informed the Council that the Catholic Church had applied for a permit to hold a raffle. Council approved the application.

Resolution 48 - Sewage and Water

M/M Nicholson, Laroux that Resolution 48 be placed in its first reading. Passed

Resolution 48 was put into its first reading by Mayor Swanson.

M/M Peltola, Nicholson that Resolution 48 be accepted in its first reading as amended and put into its 2nd reading by title only.

Amendment- M/M Nicholson, Swanson that the motion be amended to read " Reso,ution 48 Exhibit A".

Resolution 48 was put into its second and final reading by title only.

M/M Nicholson, Peltola that Resolution 48 be accepted in its 2nd and final reading. Passed.

CITY GARAGE:

M/M Nicholson, Swanson to put out a bid to remove gravel from the garage floor and fill to foundation timbers with sand and replace gravel.

Amended to read not to exceed a cost of \$500.00. Motion passed as amended.

Poll Vote Unanimous.

M/M and seconded ~~xx~~ that the City Administrator be authorized to negotiate.

M/M Peltola, Nicholson, that Hoffman, Nicholson's vehicle problems be placed on agenda. Passed.

Discussion was held on the garage doors and it was decided that Arthur Nicholson and Ed Hoffman would look over the doors in the catalog.

Motion was made and seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Passed.
