

RESOLUTION 453

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE TO REAPPROPRIATE FOR REALLOCATION TO THE CITY OF BETHEL CERTAIN GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, The Alaska State Legislature appropriated \$294,000 to the City of Bethel in Chapter 50 of 1980 for Ptarmigan and Tundraview Roads; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has an unexpended balance of \$110,049 from the above grant that could be well utilized on other road development and improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature appropriated \$75,000 to the City of Bethel in Chapter 50 of 1980 for Shelter Cabins in Southwest Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has an unexpended balance of \$40,045.06 that could be well utilized for City facility planning; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature appropriated \$259,300 to the City of Bethel in Chapter 106 of 1983 for Energy Conservation Grants and audits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has an unexpended balance of \$208,000 under the above grant that could be well utilized for the purchase of presently needed emergency equipment; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of Bethel, Alaska hereby requests the following amendments to the above listed grants;

Bethel - (Ptarmigan & Tundraview) Roads \$294,000


