Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

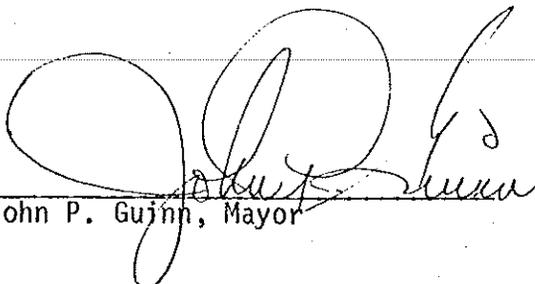
Councilman Zahradnicek walked in.

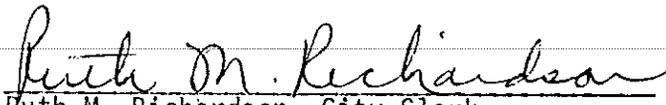
There was some discussion on the Public Works Department with the Council deciding to go in to a work session after the meeting to dicuss this matter further.
