A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT A \$1,986 GRANT AWARD FROM THE ALASKA FOOD COALITION

WHEREAS, the Alaska Food Coalition, comprised of non-profit, government, and community partners, offers mini-grants up to \$2,000 to strengthen public and private food and nutrition assistance programs in Alaska;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel's Senior Services Department offers a charitable food program to the community and therefore is eligible to receive Alaska Food Coalition grants;


WHEREAS, the current 12 cubic foot refrigerator in use at the Senior Center is 20 years old, in disrepair, and unreliable as a means to store food safely;

WHEREAS, an increase in community food donations to the Senior Center has created a need to expand the amount of cold storage space in the kitchen;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel was awarded its Alaska Food Coalition grant application that requested \$1,986 to cover the cost of purchasing a new 20 cubic foot refrigerator and plans to purchase the refrigerator with grant funds and use money in the Senior Services budget to cover shipping charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council accepts the grant award of \$1,986 from the Alaska Food Coalition for the purchase of a new 20 cubic foot refrigerator that will go into use in the Senior Center kitchen and benefit elders who participate in the Senior Center's food program.
