MMS/Weise, Hoffman that the ballots of October 1, 1963 as read be adopted and new council members be accepted. MC.

MMS/Weise, Hoffman that the ^{new} council members be ceded to the Council. MC.

Weise nominated Swanson as Mayor, Baker nominated Schirmer.

MMS/Schirmer, Weise that nominations be closed. MC.

Voting for nominees by secret ballot. Voting results: Swanson 5, Schirmer 2.

New Mayor--Dave Swanson.

MMS/Weise, Hoffman that the ballots be accepted as tabulated. MC.

Minutes of the July 12th, Sept. 16th and Sept. 30th meeting were read and accepted as read.

October 21 was set up by the Chair as the date for the Financial meeting to draft the budget for the year.

MMS/Schirmer, Weise to pay NC bill on Sanitation service. Weise, Hoffman, Sallison, Mendola, Baker, Schirmer in favor.

MMS/Schirmer, Weise that the previous motion on the NC bill be held in abeyance for final disposition on Oct. 21. MC.

Ordinance 14 was reread.

MMS/Schirmer, Mendola that Sect. 6 be amended by the addition of the word "adult" between three and persons. MC.

The Ordinance was then advanced to its 2nd and ^{third} ~~final~~ reading by title only.

MMS/Hoffman, Schirmer that Ordinance 14 be accepted as amended. Weise, Hoffman, Sallison, Mendola, Baker, and Schirmer in favor.

MMS/Weise, Schirmer that the council, as a whole, resolves to hear any delegations from the floor. MC.

MMS/Mendola, Hoffman for the reappointment of City Clerk and the State Police Contract for 1 year. MC.

MMS/Weise, Hoffman that Don Schirmer be appointed as Financial Chairman. MC.

Names were suggested for the 12 member Liquor Petition Committee to be formulated to set up rules and regulations for the selling of liquor by the City of Bethel. These names were then submitted to the council members for vote by secret ballot.

The 12 receiving the highest number of votes were: Cliff Anderson, Dave Swanson, Chuch O'Brien, Butch Laroux, Nora Buinn, Burgy Lein, Max Fancher, Bob Mulcahey, Jack Weise, Father Corrigan, Murlin Day, and James Hoffman.

MMS/Weise, Hoffman that the council accept the Liquor Petition Committee of 12 as appointed at meeting of October 8, 1963 and as designated by Paragraph 5 (Findings of Liquor Petition Review Committee), recorded in minutes of June 17, 1963 meeting. MC.

MMS/Hoffman, Weise that the meeting be continued. MC.

Joe Mendola and Ed Hoffman appointed as Street Light Committee by the Chair.
