ORDINANCE #05-13

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CHANGE IN ANIMAL CONTROL FEES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS the City of Bethel ("City") has an interest in reducing the number of uncontrolled animals in the City and a need to fund increasingly expensive methods of animal control;

WHEREAS an increase in the animal control fees and charges will act as a deterrent to those failing to comply with chapter 6.04 of the Bethel Municipal Code and will provide necessary funding for new methods of animal control;

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is not permanent or general in nature and shall not be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. The section entitled Animal Control in the Fees and Charges Schedule adopted in ordinance #01-06 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. The attached Animal Control Fees and Charges schedule is hereby adopted. It shall be adhered to by all City Departments.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after the passage of this ordinance.
