## ORDINANCE # 96-23

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING TITLE 4.16 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLED "SALES TAX."**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:**

Section 1. Classification. This is a code ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any part or provision of the ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in the controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.

Section 3. Content. Section 4.16.030 shall be amended as follows (new text is underlined, deleted text is overstruck):


### 4.16.030 Exemptions--Enumerated.

The following persons are exempt from payment of sales tax upon presentation to any seller of a valid exemption certificate and reasonable identification.


A. All persons ~~sixty-five~~ years of age and older who have been bona fide residents of the state of Alaska for not less than thirty consecutive days and who have obtained a certificate of exemption from the city and are purchaseing goods for their own use or consumption or for the use or consumption of their spouse

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
