Minutes of the City Council Meeting

September 10, 1962

At the National Guard Armory

The meeting was called to order at approximately 8:00 P.M.

Present: Miyasato, Gibson, Hoffman, Gamble, Schirmer and Swanson

Correspondance was read.

The secretary is instructed to write to the Fish and Wildlife stating the City Limits are within a radius of three miles from N.C.Co.

A letter is to be written to Richard Downing stating the City of Bethel wishes to obtain a list of excess equipment available from the state.

MMS Hoffman/Gamble that someone be appointed to look further into the Cheverlet, described in the letter from Alaska Sales and Service, and also into the jeeps. MC

As Don Shantz was in Anchorage the secretary was to try to reach him by phone to have him look at said car, if he was unalbe to be reached Jimmy Hoffman was to look at it when in Anchorage.

MMS Gibson/Miyasato to write a letter of appreciation to Trooper Redston for securing a red light and siren for the fire truck and also to request same for police vehicle. MC

MMS Gibson/Swanson that the City Council through Rev. Gamble write a letter to the former policeman expressing the Appreciation of all the council for his meritorious service, and efforts. MC

MMS Gibson/Swanson that Darrel Co Connick be appointed policeman until such time as a permanent man is hired, that the policeman protem be paid a salary of \$700.00 per month for as long as he serves in this capacity and that his period of service be extended two weeks beyond arrival of new policeman, for the purpose of breaking him in. Swanson, Miyasato Gibson, and Gamble in favor. Hoffman opposed. Motion carried.

MMS Gamble/Miyasato that we pay Don Schmidt the extra pay of \$100.00 for the month that he worked extra after his resignation. Gamble, Hoffman, Gibson, Miyasato and Swanson in Favor.

MMS Swanson/Gibson that Earth Moving and Construction be hired to haul some dirt in around the front part of the jail, in an amount not to exceed \$75.00. Swanson, Miyasateo, Gibson, Hoffman, Gable in favor.

MMS Gamble/Swanson that the secretary write to the Cities of Keni, Kotzebue, Saldatna, Douglas and the University of Aleska, asking for a copy of their agreement with the State, in regards to a State Trooper, and to ask for

any suggestions they may have for us in case we should enter into a similar contract. Also to state that we will reimburse them for any expense for thermo-fax copies that may incur. MC.

MMS Swanson/Gibson to approve the appointment of Ted Samuelson, Betty Lewis, Jay Cooke, Alice Miller, and Mary Kohl as election judges. that Ted Samuelson is to act as the inspector. MC

MMS Gamble/Hoffman to continue paying the jail guards \$1.65 per hour and to bill the State for \$1.50. MC

MMS Swanson/Gamble to continue meeting as necessary.

MMSGamble/Miyato that a committee of Mr. Gibson and Mr. Swanson be appointed to confer with Mr. Ellis concerning his proposal for Sewage and Garbage disposal and to report back to the Council. The report to include a tentative agreement. MC

Ordinance No. 19 concerning the leasing of the City owned Sewage and Garbage truck was read, and placed in first reading. It was then moved to place Ordinance No. 19 in second reading, by title only. MC The ordinance was then read by title only. It was then moved to place Ordinance No. 19 in the third and final reading by title only. MC Swanson/Gibson that Ordinance No. 19 be passed. Ordinance No. 19 was passed with 5 ayes and 0 nays.

The secretary is to write to the Lawyer concerning accepting bonds for City prisoners, to determine if we can pass a resolution not to accept them and if we have to have an ordinance to accept them. Also to ask concerning the sale of building obtained from the Alaska Division of Aviation.

MMS Gamble/Swanson to write a letter of appreciation to Rev. Elston Page for interviewing Mr. Walsh and those he gave as recommendations. MC

MMS Swanson/Gamble to write a letter to Ray Pertson, informing him of remarks made by one of his employees to Mr. Walsh, not mentioning names.
