**A Resolution of the Bethel City Council accepting the  
Bethel Boardwalk Improvements Project**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel is the land owner of Pinky's Park;

**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities funded the \$1.5 million dollar Bethel Boardwalk Improvements Project in Pinky's Park; and

**WHEREAS**, Northern Contracting Service, owned by Roger McCormick completed the work for the project; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel representatives from the Public Works Department and Parks and Recreation Department completed the required walk through on June 27, 2003 and all the recommended corrections were completed; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel passed Ordinance #01-31 authorizing a public easement and a maintenance agreement for the project and all terms and conditions have been met;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Bethel accepts the Bethel Boardwalk Improvements and agrees that the City will maintain the project for 20 years and bears all related costs.
