**RESOLUTION #93-33**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING CAPITAL PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUESTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995 AND REQUESTING APPROPRIATE FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS FOR PARKS AND RECREATION PROJECTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bethel has determined a need to provide enrichment opportunities for the community; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the City Council to enhance the quality of life and provide for recreation for the residents and visitors to the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the following projects would have a positive impact on the community, specifically our youth who are seeking positive recreational activities;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that the following projects are identified as projects of community-wide benefit and are included in the list of Capital Improvement Projects/Legislative Requests for Fiscal Year 1995:

1.	Pinky's Park and Other Park Improvements/Renovation (Baseball and Basketball Field and boardwalk repair, drainage problem alleviation)	\$	400,000
2.	Community Recreation Center and Facilities		3,000,000
3.	Creation of New Parks		300,000
	Total Costs	\$	3,700,000

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature and the Department of Community and Regional Affairs of the projects supported by the City Council for the Fiscal Year 1995 and to take all appropriate steps to provide the necessary background information.
