A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA ESTABLISHING  
A PROGRAM REDUCTION OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICE PATROL/DETOX  
PROGRAM WITHIN THE PHILLIPS ALCOHOLISM TREATMENT CENTER (PATC)  
DUE TO BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Phillips Alcoholism Treatment Center, a department  
of the City of Bethel, must cease to operate the  
Community Service Patrol/Detox activities within  
ninety (90) days; and


WHEREAS, two thirds (2/3) of all Community Service Patrol clients  
maintain a residence outside of Bethel; and


WHEREAS, there is no apparent way to receive compensation for  
services rendered by the Community Service Patrol/  
Detox unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel places its priority toward the  
services of primary/secondary treatment prevention and  
education in lieu of declining funding and revenues,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of  
Bethel, Alaska, that services of the Community Service Patrol/  
Detox unit of Phillips Alcoholism Treatment Center (PATC) will  
be terminated by the City of Bethel on/or before September 30, 1983.
