RESOLUTION #93-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (CDBG-REDI) PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, wishes to provide for the upgrade of honeybucket sanitation systems in the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel would provide the water and sewer tanks necessary to the eligible residents for installation of a flush toilet system; and

WHEREAS, the City would also provide for upgrading structurally weak floors to support water tanks and associated plumbing; and

WHEREAS, this entity is an applicant for a grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs (hereinafter "Department"), under the CDBG-REDI program.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager of the City of Bethel is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents required for granting and managing funds on behalf of this organization; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager of the City of Bethel is also authorized to execute subsequent amendments to said grant agreement to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the project.
