WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council being duly elected and representative of population of Bethel choose to reflect community needs and priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel Police and Fire Departments provide critical emergency services essential to the protection of life and property; and


WHEREAS, any reduction of these services will have direct impact on the welfare of the citizens of Bethel; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these services be accorded the highest priority in resources allocation consistent with community needs.
