RESOLUTION NO. 350

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL FUNDS FOR A RIVERBANK EROSION CONTROL/MOORAGE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has approved a Municipal Grant of \$5,250,000.00 for riverbank erosion control and dock moorage projects in Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has experienced extreme erosion of the Kuskokwim Riverbank; and

WHEREAS, riverbank erosion continues at an accelerated rate every year which will cause severe loss of private property if nothing is done to control the erosion; and

WHEREAS, the inadequate size of the medium draft port facility requires that a riverbarge moorage area be developed to provide for smoother flow of goods through the port facility; and


WHEREAS, the 8.5 million gallon Chevron U.S.A. tank farm is being seriously threatened by riverbank erosion.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the State of Alaska, Department of Administration for a Riverbank Erosion Control/Moorage Project.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in acceptance and implementation of this grant award.
