A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, FOR THE OPERATION OF A MUNICIPAL BUS SYSTEM AT BETHEL, ALASKA.


WHEREAS, Section 18 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provides for capital and operating grants to public transit providers for the purpose of assisting them in providing public transportation services; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature is authorized to receive and expend federal funds for mass urban transportation projects to recognized providers of public transportation services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has been designated as a provider of public transportation in accordance with the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, grant to the City of Bethel funds in the amount of \$12,561.00 for the purpose of assisting the City of Bethel to provide public transportation services at Bethel, Alaska.
