

RESOLUTION #667

**REQUESTING CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA,
VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM**

- WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council desires to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of Bethel, Alaska; and
- WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council has established wastewater treatment system improvements as the number one priority for the community; and
- WHEREAS, previous engineering evaluations have determined that the 28-acre facultative wastewater treatment lagoon, in its present configuration, is at or beyond capacity; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Conservation has issued a Notice of Violation and subsequent Compliance Order by Consent because the City is unable to consistently meet effluent discharge quality standards as stipulated by the facility's operating permit; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Conservation, Village Safe Water (VSW) program can provide technical assistance to improve water, sewer and solid waste facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Bethel City Council requests the Governor and Legislature appropriate \$623,000 through the VSW program to design and construct the Bethel - wastewater treatment system improvement project.
