

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT SHELTER CABINS IN SOUTHWEST ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature approved a Municipal Grant to the City of Bethel in the amount of \$75,000.00 to construct shelter cabins in Southwest Alaska, and

WHEREAS, there exists a pressing need for emergency shelters that may provide a safe haven for individuals traveling between villages, and/or the City of Bethel, and


WHEREAS, no shelters that can provide a safe haven currently exist, sometimes resulting in injury or death due to exposure.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Administration for the City of Bethel to construct shelter cabins in Southwest Alaska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
