

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL, REGULATE, IMPOUND, & LICENSE DOGS WITHIN THE <sup>City</sup>VILLAGE OF BETHEL, ALASKA, NAMING FEES AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the <sup>City</sup>Village Council of the Village of Bethel, Alaska:

SECTION 1. SECURING DOGS - All work dogs and any of a vicious or dangerous nature shall be chained by its or their owner in a substantial manner at a safe distance from public walks, paths and streets.

SECTION 2. PETS - All canine pets permitted to run at large by the owner shall wear a collar bearing the name of its owner or a license tag issued by the Village.

SECTION 3. LICENSES - By Resolution the Council may require that all <sup>pet</sup>dogs within the village be required to have a license purchased from the <sup>City</sup>Village Treasurer of Bethel, which shall cost \$2.00 for each male dog and \$5.00 for each female dog. Proceeds from the sale of these licenses shall go toward the enforcement of this ordinance or for vaccination of dogs against rabies where the owner permits and cannot afford to pay for such treatment.

\$5.00 for female

SECTION 4. DOG POUND - The <sup>City</sup>Village shall maintain a dog pound and any pet dogs found running at large without a license, or if no license fee is resolved by the Council, then without a collar and the owner's name thereon, or if any work dog or vicious dog is found running at large, or chained so near a public walk, path or street so as to endanger humans, the person appointed

by the Council shall seize and impound said dog.

The dog so impounded shall be held five days and if not claimed and impounding fees paid after five days the dog shall be sold by the Village <sup>City</sup> or destroyed.

SECTION 5. FEES - The fee for impounding said dog shall be \$5.00 which shall also cover the cost of feeding the dog the first day. A charge of \$1.00 per day shall be made for the next four days.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE - This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.
