ORDINANCE #95-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 9.08.050 ENTITLED FIREWORKS AND EXPLOSIVES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Title 9, of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended by revising Chapter 9.08.050, Fireworks and Explosives.


Section 2: If any part or provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in all controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this title or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.

Section 3: Chapter 9.08.050 of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby adopted as follows:

9.08.050 Fireworks and Explosives. It is unlawful for any person in the city to sell use or explode any fireworks, explosive or stench bomb, to which fuses are attached or which are ignitable by means of a match, without the majority decision of the chief of police, the fire chief and the city manager. In the event of an absence of the chief of police, the fire chief or the city manager, the mayor shall serve as an alternate.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
