### **RESOLUTION #02-14**

#### **A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF BETHEL ACQUIRING OWNERSHIP OF THE MUNICIPAL DOCK IN REGARD TO SENATE BILL No. 111**

**WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel has discussed with the Alaska Department of Transportation (DOT) the possibility of accepting possession, control and title to the municipal dock, and;

**WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel is willing and able to accept title to and control of the municipal dock, but the City is not financially capable of accepting title if such acceptance would also require the City to assume responsibility for the deferred maintenance, and;

**WHEREAS,** The City would accept title if allocated \$591,000 for deferred maintenance and DOT has completed its 2002 deferred maintenance survey of the Bethel municipal dock, and;

**WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel supports the intent of the Legislature to provide for the required investment, and intent of transfer of ultimate ownership of and responsibility for the state-owned harbor facilities to local municipalities as described in Senate Bill No. 111.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, desires to inform the Alaska Department of Transportation and the Alaska Legislature that the City desires to receive title to the municipal dock and will accept a conveyance of the municipal dock if such conveyance is coupled with an appropriation of funds sufficient to pay for deferred maintenance.
